The Event:

Beauty Kenya is the prime international Beauty & Cosmetics trade event in the region attracting visitors from 10 African countries. Exhibitors from 18 countries have already confirmed participation at the exhibition.

The exhibition is organized by Grow Exhibitions, the largest trade exhibitions organizer in Africa that hosts 14 trade events in 11 African countries annually.

Why Kenya?

⇒ Kenya is the gateway to the entire East & the Central African region having one the busiest ports, Mombasa

⇒ Imports rose by 14.5 per cent in 2024.

⇒ The Port of Mombasa recorded a growth of 11.7 per cent in total cargo throughput handled from 22.3 million tonnes in 2023 to 24.9 million tonnes in 2024.

⇒ Total air passenger and cargo traffic handled at the airports rose by 7.9 and 6.8 per cent, respectively in 2024

⇒ The country's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is estimated to have expanded by 5.3 per cent in 2024

⇒ The Performance of the Kenya Shilling was quite stable against major currencies in Africa (1 USD = 129 Kenya Shillings, Jan 2025)

General & Market Information:

With a population of 44 million, Kenya is the land of contrasts, as it is described, covers an area of 583,000 sq.Km which is roughly the size of France. Kenya is believed to be the perfect combination of modern and natural beauty. Known worldwide for its wildlife and safari destination, it also boasts of the mighty Mount Kenya, several savannahs, lakes and beaches, excellent climate & hospitable people. Kenya shares borders with five nations, which are Tanzania (769Km), Uganda (933Km), Sudan (232Km), Ethiopia (830Km) and Somalia (682 Km). Kenya's biggest investment is mainly in the agricultural sector where most of its exports come from. Kenya's major trading business partners are Britain, Germany, France, USA, Japan, United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia, Uganda and India.

The Exhibition Venue:

The exhibition will be held at Sarit Expo Centre, westlands, the perfect venue for hosting International trade exhibitions in Nairobi. It is situated in the central business district of Nairobi. The exhibitions attract trade visitors from all the sectors of Kenya and the neighbouring countries such as Uganda, Somalia, Tanzania and Ethiopia. It offers high standard facilities, equipment & services. The exhibition centre also offers round the clock security, press & media rooms, information centre, Toilets & lavatories, warehouse and restaurants.

Participating Countries:

Participating countries are Belgium, Canada, China, Columbia, Denmark, France, Germany, Hong Kong, India, Italy, Kenya, Malaysia, Pakistan, Saudi Arabia, South Africa,, Tanzania, Thailand & UAE.

Summary of Last Exhibition:

The exhibition was attended by exhibitors from 18 countries. The exhibitor survey indicated prospective and confirmed business transactions worth US\$ 24 million approximately while 6,600 business / trade visitors were estimated to have visited the exhibition.
