



Economy

- According to the IMF, Ethiopia is expected to achieve a 6.5% real gross domestic product (GDP) growth rate by the end of 2025, with a 7.1 % growth rate predicted for 2026.
- Ethiopia's GDP has reached 210 billion USD, with an average GDP growth for the last three years of 7.4%.
- Ethiopia has the 3rd largest Economy in sub-Saharan Africa.
- Ethiopia is focused on promoting industrialization to drive economic growth and create employment opportunities.
- The government has implemented various initiatives to attract FDI and has achieved 3.92 billion USD FDI inflow in 2023/24, making it the number 1st FDI destination in East Africa and the 3rd highest FDI inflow in Africa in 2022/23.
- Ethiopia aims to reach lower-middle-income status by the end of 2025.

Pharmaceutical Supply and Service

- The Ministry of Health, in collaboration with the Ministry of Finance and other stakeholders, has announced that local manufacturers will have up to 55% of foreign currency facilitation support.
- The Ethiopian pharmaceutical market was valued at 1.5\$ billion in 2022 and has grown at around 10% per annum over the last five years and will reach 2.6 \$ billion in 2030.
- Currently, over 80% - 90% of pharmaceutical demand is met through imports, creating a significant opportunity for local production
- Public sector purchases account for 60% of the pharmaceutical market by the Ethiopian Pharmaceuticals Supply Service (EPSS).
- The government has opened a state-of-the-art, 270-hectare Industrial Park, Kilinto Park, Africa's first dedicated industrial park for pharmaceutical manufacturing.
- Investment opportunities: Potential to serve >\$70 billion pharmaceutical market in Africa.

Facts and Figures-Ethiopia

Healthcare Spending

- The health sector spending in 2020 was ETB 127 billion (~USD 3.63 billion), and out of pocket expenditure was 46%.
- Healthcare expenditure is 3.9% of the GDP in the year 2024.
- National Budget allocation to the health sector is 12.3% of its GDP (75% on essential medicines and services)
- Increased number of health professionals' training institutions (public and private sectors) and programs
- Introduction of insurance schemes (e.g., Community-Based Health Insurance system (55%), third-party road accident)

Diplomatic Relations

- Ethiopia is Africa's diplomatic capital, being a seat for the African Union (AU), the United Nations Economic Commissions for Africa (UNECA) with its 20+ agencies, and the Pan African Chamber of Commerce and Industries (PACCI)
- Host to Numerous Diplomatic Missions: As of December 2024, Addis Ababa hosts 137 foreign embassies, underscoring its status as a prominent diplomatic hub.
- Ethiopia is officially part of the BRICS (Brazil, Russia, India, China, and South Africa) group of emerging economies as of January 2024

Trade Agreements

- Ethiopia is one of the 44 countries in Africa that ratified the Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA) access to 1.4 billion consumers and a combined GDP of \$3.4 trillion.
- Ethiopia is a member of the Common Market for Eastern and Southern Africa (COMESA), giving it access to a market of 560 million people.
- Ethiopia is a member of the Intergovernmental Authority on Development (IGAD)
- Ethiopia has signed Bilateral Investment Treaties (BITs) with 30 countries and Double Taxation Avoidance Treaties (DTTs) with 12 countries.
- Ethiopia is using the opportunity of Generalized System Preferences (GSP), and Everything but Arms (EBA)


